Ratification of Board Action taken via Email

SDBC President Mike McLaughlin sent the following message and motion to the Board of Directors on Monday, March 16<sup>th</sup>:

The CDC issued this advice yesterday, Sunday, March 15th:

"...in accordance with its guidance for <u>large events and mass gatherings</u>, CDC recommends that for the <u>next 8 weeks</u>, organizers (whether groups or individuals) cancel or postpone in-person events that consist of 50 people or more throughout the United States."

This is for all event through May 15th. Today, Monday, officials are now recommending events of more than 10 people be postponed or canceled. And the dining rooms of all San Diego county restaurants have just been ordered closed for the next two weeks.

Given these rapidly changing developments, the Executive Committee met earlier this afternoon via a conference call along with Charlie Sykes, our Training Director responsible for our Saturday rides, and Graham Johnson, our Executive Race Director responsible for Barrio Logan Grand Prix. Mike Barreras our Fiesta Island Time Trial Director was invited to join the conference call but was unable to do so. (In a follow-up phone call with Mike, he said he supports the action.) <u>Our purpose was to review the current recommendations from CDC and other agency, along with USAC's expected expansion of permit cancelations, and how SDBC should respond to them.</u>

During the conference call the following motion was made by Vice President Renee Robinson, and seconded by Secretary Ed Leonard. It passed unanimously by all present.

#### Moved that:

A. The following San Diego Bicycle Club events be suspended until further notice:

- 1. The Saturday Club Rides.
- 2. The 2020 Barrio Logan Grand Prix to be rescheduled in late summer, if possible.
- 3. The April 12, 2020 Fiesta Island Time Trial we will attempt to reschedule.
- 4. A decision for the May 10, 2020 Fiesta Island Time Trial will be made by May 1st.

*B.* The April 6, and May 4, 2020 Board meetings be conducted electronically via computer and telephone, with instruction to the membership as to how they can join in.

C. The Executive Committee is to monitor guidance from The Centers for Disease Control, federal, state, & local agencies, and USA Cycling. The Executive Committee is authorized to take additional steps as necessary to comply with orders and/or guidance pertaining to controlling the spread of the coronavirus, and to resume Club events at the soonest appropriate time. (Moved by Vice President Renee Robinson/ Seconded by Secretary Ed Leonard.)

#### ((end of motion))

Following a 23 hour review and comment period, and without amendment, the Board voted on the motion.

Motion passed 22-1-0.

The Club's membership was notified of the Board's action via email on March 18, 2020, and in the Weekly Update on March 19, 2020.
